

The following are the words discussed during the podcast with their unique definitions and scripture references [this is NOT an exhaustive list].

- **Worship** – adopting a posture or position of humbleness before an almighty God
 - Shachah – to bow in reverence
 - Psalm 95:6 “Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!”
 - Proskuneo - to kiss the hand in reverence
 - John 4:24 “God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.”
 - Latreuo – to give homage or to serve
 - Philippians 3:3 “For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh.”
- **Praise** – The fruit of our lips, verbal and audible worship
 - Halal – to express or say
 - Psalm 63:5 “My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips”
 - Tehillah – to express with or without instruments
 - Psalm 40:3 “He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in the Lord.”
 - Ainesis – to praise or give thanks
 - Hebrews 13:15 “Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name.”
- **Use of hands** – physically expressing worship to God with our hands
 - Taqa – to clap
 - Psalm 47:1 “Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!”
 - Nasa – to lift one’s hands
 - Psalm 134:2 “Lift up your hands to the holy place and bless the Lord!”
 - Paras – to extend one’s hands
 - Psalm 143:6 “I stretch out my hands to you; my soul thirsts for you like a parched land. Selah.”
 - Yadah - to praise while using your hands
 - Psalms 33:2 “Give thanks to the Lord with the lyre; make melody to him with the harp of ten strings!”

- Nagan – to play instruments
 - Psalm 33:3 “Sing to him a new song; play skillfully on the strings, with loud shouts.”
- **Glorify** – worshipping God by showing Him respect, admiration, and esteeming Him highly
 - Doxazo – to esteem in the highest fashion
 - Luke 18:43 “And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.”
- **Magnify** – choosing to make God greater and increasing our perspective of Him
 - Gadai – to elevate or increase
 - Psalm 34:3 “Oh, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together!”
 - Megaluno – to show something to be great
 - Luke 1:46 “And Mary said, “My soul magnifies the Lord,”
- **Rejoice/Sing/Shout** – bringing an increased volume into our worship
 - Shabach – to say with great volume
 - Psalm 63:3 “Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.”
 - Ruwa – to shout, triumph, sound the alarm
 - Psalm 66:1 “Shout for joy to God, all the earth;”
 - Ranan – to shout with joy
 - Psalm 98:4 “Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises!”
 - Gol – to vocalize like thunder
 - Psalm 95:1 “Oh come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!”
 - Patsach – to worship like an explosion of sound
 - Psalm 100:1 “Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth!”
 - Giyl – to rejoice
 - Psalm 32:11 “Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!”
 - Renanah – to exclaim the victory
 - Psalm 100:2 “Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into his presence with singing!”
- **Celebration** – worshipping God with joy, happiness, and thankfulness
 - Hilluwl – to celebrate by giving thanks

- Leviticus 19:24 "And in the fourth year all its fruit shall be holy, an offering of praise to the Lord."
 - Samach – to have happiness
 - Psalm 31:7 "I will rejoice and be glad in your steadfast love, because you have seen my affliction; you have known the distress of my soul,"
 - Alats – to jump for joy, to celebrate victory
 - Psalm 68:3 "But the righteous shall be glad; they shall exult before God; they shall be jubilant with joy!"
- **Dance** – worshipping God through the physical act of dancing
 - Machowl – to dance or to dance in a group
 - Psalm 149:3 "Let them praise his name with dancing, making melody to him with tambourine and lyre!"
